

Video Surveillance – Hexpol TPE AB

Why do we use your personal data and on what legal basis?

At Hexpol TPE AB we monitor parts of our property with cameras. The video surveillance is a safety precaution in order to handle risk of fire, break-in, damage and sabotage.

The legal basis for our video surveillance is a weighing of interests. Hexpol TPE AB's interest in securing the property outweighs those of the data subject.

What categories of personal data are processed?

Video files where a person's identity can be determined.

Who is permitted to access your personal data?

The information from the cameras are transferred to Securitas alarm centre and if a crime is suspected the Police will get access as well. Hexpol TPE AB has a personal data assistant agreement with Securitas. Read more about how Securitas handles your personal data at:

How long is your personal data saved?

Your personal data will be stored for 30 days after which it will automatically be erased from the system.
